ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION USAGE FEE AS FOLLOWS:

Charging Station Type	Electricity Fee Per kWh	Ancillary Services Fee Per Hour	Penalty Fee Per Hour (after 4 hours)
Level 2	\$0.22	\$0.50	\$2.50

Background: The City has installed charging stations on municipal property for public use. The City will establish a fee that is intended to be revenue neutral in order to recover the cost of providing the service. The fee is per unit of electricity (kWh) delivered to the vehicle being charged and a per hour ancillary fee based on the cost of installation and maintenance of the charging infrastructure, and the administrative and network fees associated with the service. After 4 hours of use an hourly penalty fee will be applied to discourage excessive usage or parking at the charging station when not actively charging a vehicle.

The complete list of fees may also be accessed in person at the City Clerk's Office, located at 275 Main Street, Suite 400, Watsonville, CA, 95076.

The hearing is established by virtue of California Government Code Sections 66016 and 66018 and notice is given pursuant California Government Code Section 6062a.

Any person may observe, make inquiries, and present testimony either for or against the fees at said public hearing. Any person may request to be notified about the action of the Council. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk, 275 Main Street, Suite 400, 4th Floor, Watsonville, CA 95076, prior to, or at, the public hearing.
